

## LOWER VALLEY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

## Posting of Occupant Load Sign(s)

An approved sign shall be posted in a conspicuous place, between 7-8 feet above the floor, near the main entrance or other location approved by the Fire District.

The occupant load sign(s) shall read as follows:
"MAXIMUM OCCUPANT LOAD is limited to persons. By order of the Fire Chief."
Where a room can be enlarged by opening a movable partition the sign(s) shall read
"MAXIMUM OCCUPANT LOAD is limited to persons or when partition is in the open position. By order of the Fire Chief"
The sign(s) shall be of permanent material (such as plastic plate) with engraved white letters and numbers 1 inch high on a red background.
On new construction architect drawings must show the occupant load calculations. On existing occupancies the LVFD will calculate or verify the maximum load. Ref: IFC 1004.3
